Your Workflow with an EMR Connection to Keet

Connecting your EMR to Keet through an integration helps to automate numerous tasks. With an established integration, patient information and identifiers automatically flow from your EMR into Keet, which improves efficiency and accuracy.

The following infographic provides an overview of automation and required tasks for clients with an EMR integration.

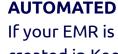

Create a **New Patient**



If your EMR is connected to Keet, a patient profile will be created in Keet when the patient is scheduled in your EMR. Required fields, such as patient identifiers, will automatically flow from your EMR into the Keet patient profile.





Send a **Patient Registration Email**

AUTOMATED

Keet can automatically send a registration email when a patient is scheduled for an initial evaluation.





Episode of Care (EOC) to Patient

When a patient is created in your EMR, a patient profile will be cre-

ated in Keet with TWO Episodes of Care. One is a "Default Episode of Care" and is required in order for the patient to be created. The second EOC will represent the patient's CASE from the EMR. This "Case" Episode of Care will always be the first case seen when a practitioner clicks on the patient profile.

Scheduled Encounter

Scheduled visits are captured from the Keet connection, we use

AUTOMATED

that information to trigger emails.





Welcome Email

AUTOMATED

A Welcome Email is sent to patients informing them of the details of their upcoming appointment at your clinic. This is automatically sent after an initial evaluation appointment type is scheduled through your EMR.





Arrived Encounter

Arrived Encounters are logged when the patient has been marked

AUTOMATED

as Arrived at the clinic within your EMR. If your EMR is connected (linked) to Keet, you can view the Encounters log for appointment data.





Care Plan to an **Episode of Care**

AUTOMATED

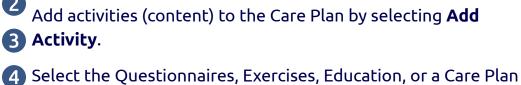
If your EMR is connected to Keet, a Care Plan is automatically added to the patient's Keet profile when an Episode of Care (Case) is created in your EMR.

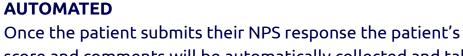
