Step 1 Download Keet Activate app

For Apple iOS users:


- a) From your iPhone or iPad, open the Apple Store
- b) Search for "Keet Activate"
- c) Select and install Keet Activate app



For Android users:

- a) From your phone or tablet, open Google Play
- b) Search for "Keet Activate"
- c) Select and install Keet Activate app







Step 2 Register for the Keet patient portal

Your provider will send you a *Welcome* to *Keet* email, be sure to have it handy before proceeding.

- a) Open your *Welcome to Keet* email and tap the **Register Here** button
- b) On the Patient Login page, confirm your information is accurate
- c) Set your user name and password
- d) Tap Confirm
- f) Tap the **I'm Ready to Log In** button



Step 3 Log into the Keet Activate app

- a) Open the Keet app on your device
- b) Tap the **Log Into Your Account** button
- d) If you receive a message asking for permission to use "Keetservices. com", tap **Continue**
- c) On the Patient Login page, enter your username and password
- d) Tap **Log In**

- a) Tap on an exercise or questionnaire from your task list to get started
- c) Tap the **History** tab to view educaton, tasks, forms, and other things to help you on your road to better health
- d) Tap the **Secure Messaging** tab to keep in touch with your provider
